

TELL ME AGAIN!

Primary Language Target:

Auditory memory: ability to recall information that one has recently seen or experienced.

Secondary Language Targets:

Receptive language skills: identifying nouns and verbs, understanding and following directions

Expressive language: naming objects and actions, using simple sentence structure, answering "wh" questions, or "yes" no questions.

Instructions:

Put all the cards in a mixed pile. Pull out at least two cards (three cards at the most) in a specific order. Point to and name each picture and have the student repeat after you. Have them look, point, and name each picture at least three times. Put those three cards back in the pile, and then have them find the same pictures you all just pointed to and named, and put them in the correct order. Provide cueing, prompting, and correcting as necessary.

While working on auditory memory, you could also target the secondary language targets used above.

Word List: cup, ball, pot, book, pen, dog, cat, bear, lion, and pig, eat, run, jump, ride, color, home, school, library, store, and playground.
