General Information

Using Language Out Loud is an interactive board game designed for children age 10 and up with expressive language disorders. This game specifically targets semantic and syntactic skills that are necessary for children to participate in meaningful communicative exchange using complete and grammatically correct sentences.

Directions

Materials:

Language Spinner

Game Markers (provide your own)

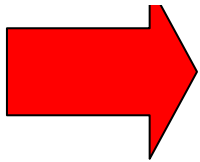
Game Cards

Game Board

How to Use:

1. Spin the spinner
2. Choose a game card (noun) from the pile
3. Use the noun from the game card in a phrase or sentence if you land on "verb" or "adjective", define the noun if you land on "define", or name the category (person, place, or thing or more specific category) if you land on "category".
4. If the player gets the question correct, move the number of spaces indicated on the spinner. Provide correction and modeling as necessary.
5. The player that reaches the end of the game board first wins.
